The original weekend series has been divided into sessions that are more manageable for a small group setting and at a pace that will allow participants to take the time to engage deeply in the material.

The prayers and tools offered here are a framework for engaging with the material and may introduce you to new ways of praying and engaging with God. They are not formulas and are simply meant to guide you rather than restrict you. Feel free to adapt them in ways that serve you.

Joining together on this journey of Encounter is exciting. The group of people you are gathering with today will be transformed. By the time you have completed the course of this material, you will be more deeply in love with Jesus, more fully experiencing the work of the Holy Spirit, and better equipped to be on mission with Jesus releasing His kingdom here on earth as it is in heaven. Commit to gathering regularly for this course. Establish your small group as a place of confidentiality and safety. Commit to sharing and learning from each other with humility and curiosity and without judgement.

- For Session Three (Expectancy without Agenda), you will want to have communion elements.
- Session Nine (Ministry from Above) refers to a clip from a video called Holy Ghost Reborn by Darren Wilson. - While it is not required for this series, Doug Balzer's book The Empowerment Pivot is a helpful
